

2021 Badge of Honor College Scholarship Program

Wheelhouse Credit Union is pleased to support the educational efforts of children of first responders in San Diego County through its 2021 Badge of Honor College Scholarship Program. This year, we will recognize and reward five exceptional graduating high school seniors who excelled during their high school career and demonstrate traits of leadership, a commitment to public service, and a desire to make an impact on their schools and communities.

Five (5) students will each be awarded a \$1,000 college scholarship.

Eligibility and Requirements

- 1. Each applicant must meet the following requirements to be eligible for the 2021 Badge of Honor College Scholarship:
 - ➤ Have a parent, grandparent or legal guardian who is an active member of law enforcement, fire protection service, healthcare or EMT in San Diego County.
 - ➤ Graduating high school senior in San Diego County, from the class of 2021.
 - ➤ Have a cumulative high school GPA of 3.0 or better, based upon a 4.0 scale.
 - Acceptance by, or plans to attend, an accredited college/university on a full-time basis beginning fall 2021.
 - Submit a completed and signed application form online. All applications must be submitted online through WheelhouseCU.com/Scholarships by March 31, 2021 and contain all the components together in pdf format. Incomplete applications will not be considered.

- 4. Notification will be mailed to the scholarship recipients shortly after the Committee's decision.
- 5. Each award recipient will be required to submit a photo of themselves which may be used for public relations purposes. Signed permission must be obtained with the photo submission to be eligible for the award.
- 6. This Scholarship is a one-time award and will be payable no later than **July 31, 2021**. Each recipient's award check will be sent directly to the college/university of their choice.
