

2024 Badge of Honor College Scholarship Program

Wheelhouse Credit Union is pleased to support the educational efforts of children of first responders in San Diego County through its 2024 Badge of Honor College Scholarship Program. This year, we will recognize and reward five (5) exceptional graduating high school seniors who excelled during their high school career and demonstrate traits of leadership, a commitment to public service, and a desire to make an impact on their schools and communities.

Five (5) students will each be awarded a \$1,000 college scholarship.

Eligibility and Requirements

- WHO MAY ENTER/ELIGIBILITY. Each applicant must meet the following requirements to be eligible for the 2024 Sustainable College Scholarship:
 - 1. Have a parent, grandparent or legal guardian who is an active member of law enforcement, fire protection service, healthcare or EMT in San Diego County.
 - 2. Be a "Class of 2024" graduating high school senior in San Diego County.
 - 3. Have a cumulative high school GPA of 3.0 or better, based upon a 4.0 scale.
 - 4. Acceptance by, or plans to attend, an accredited college/university on a full-time basis beginning Fall 2024.
 - 5. Submit a completed and signed application along with all the required documents by **April 30**, **2024**, at **11:59:59 PDT**. **Incomplete applications will not be considered**.
- HOW TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION. Eligible students may complete the official application and submit supporting documents, in PDF format, online by visiting WheelhouseCU.com/Scholarships by 11:59:59 PDT, Tuesday, April 30, 2024.

Alternative Method of Entry (AMOE). You may also submit your completed application and supporting documents to one of our four (4) branch locations or mail it to:

All AMOE applications must be received by 11:59:59 PDT, Tuesday, April 30, 2024, to qualify.

- **SELECTION PROCESS.** The Wheelhouse Scholarship Committee will determine the awards. The awards selection is at Wheelhouse's sole and complete discretion. Wheelhouse reserves the right to make changes to the Scholarship Program at any time and all decisions will be final.
- Notification will be mailed to the scholarship recipients shortly after the decision, along with an invitation to be recognized at the presentation ceremony.

- Publicity. Each scholarship recipient will be required to submit a photo of themselves, which may be
 used for public relations purposes. A signed model release form must be received with the photo
 submission to be eligible for the award. Please note: if you are under 18, your parent or legal
 guardian must provide consent by signing the model release form.
- This scholarship is a one-time award and will be payable no later than July 31, 2024. Each recipient's
 award check will be presented directly to the recipient during the presentation ceremony. If the
 recipient is not able to attend, other arrangements will be made to deliver the award.
