Leadership Message

For nearly 90 years, Wheelhouse Credit Union has proudly served our community, making life a little easier for our Members every year. While enduring another year of COVID pandemic related challenges and inflationary pressure, the Credit Union, expanded our support in the community, invested in innovative technology, developed new partnerships to enhance the Member experience, served as a top lender in solar and energy-efficient loans, and continued to give back to our community.

Through the loyalty of our Members and the exceptional work of our dedicated team, we are pleased to report a positive financial performance, along with impressive growth. Wheelhouse ended the year with \$429M in total assets, a growth of 10.3%, and \$358M in Loans, an annual increase of 21.8%. Net income remained strong at \$1.2M, and membership grew 7% to 31,235 Members proudly served.

As a member-owned cooperative, our members' best interests will always be our top priority. Creating a seamless experience for our Members, continues to be our key focus. During this past year,

Wheelhouse enhanced digital banking capabilities, introduced Zelle® (a feature that makes it easy for Members to send and receive money electronically), refreshed the website for easier navigation, increased financial education to empower our Members, and provided new tools through social media and video assets. We also closely monitored the market to provide the best loan rates, high-rate certificates and IRAs, and saving options to give Members the ability to earn a greater return on their hard-earned money.

Our commitment to sustainability and steadfast support of the environment continues to be reflected in holding the top honor of being San Diego's #1 Solar Financing Lender. These efforts, coupled with our support of the City of San Diego's binding commitment to switch to 100% renewable energy, are reflected in our Credit Union assisting nearly 20,000 Members with their solar systems to date. These solar systems produce a combined 254.4M kWh of electricity per year.

Our commitment to sustainability and our steadfast support of the environment continues to be reflected in holding the top honor of being San Diego's #1 Solar Financing Lender.

Wheelhouse Credit Union is dedicated to helping better our communities through a wide variety of sponsorships. We support several causes through financial contributions and staff volunteering. You can find our Team in Red Shirts sporting the hashtag #itsgivebacktime out on the trail for Make-A-Wish San Diego's annual Trailblaze Challenge, cleaning up our beaches and parks alongside I Love a Clean San Diego, planting trees in communities with the Arbor Day Foundation and more. We also sponsored an Alternative Fuels Exhibit at the San Diego Automotive Museum and awarded 10 college scholarships to San Diego high school seniors, empowering them to further their education and encouraging them to use their knowledge for the betterment of all.

Supervisory Committee

The Wheelhouse Supervisory Committee is comprised of volunteer members who independently evaluate internal controls ensuring they are followed by management. A primary responsibility of the Supervisory Committee is to hire an external audit firm to review the Credit Union's internal controls, financial statements, and to verify the loan and share accounts of the members. The Supervisory Committee engaged the national CPA firm, Turner, Warren, Hwang & Conrad AC (TWHC) to perform the Annual Financial Audit as of December 31, 2022. TWHC's responsibility, as prescribed by professional standards, is to express an opinion about whether the financial statements prepared by management with oversight are fairly presented, in all material respects, in conformity with accounting principles generally accepted in the United States of America.

The audited financials were presented to the Supervisory Committee and Board of Directors and filed with the records of the Credit Union, as well as submitted, as required, to State and Federal regulators. The Supervisory Committee is pleased to share, the audit report, contained an unqualified opinion and confirmed the Credit Union's Financial Statements for the year ended December 31, 2022, were materially correct and fairly presented in conformity with U.S. Generally Accepted Accounting Principles.
